Program Overview

Thailand is moving toward achieving the global “30x30” biodiversity target under the Global Biodiversity Framework and Thailand’s National Biodiversity Action Plan 2023-2027, which aims to conserve at least 30% of terrestrial, inland waters, and coastal and marine areas by 2030. The focus on Other Effective Area-based Conservation Measures (OECMs) is particularly relevant and plays a key role in the global target, still achieve positive and sustained long-term outcomes for biodiversity conservation.

The session will be an excellent opportunity to learn from the practical application of OECMs in Thailand. The keynote speakers will share insights and experiences from five recognized OECM sites in Thailand. This shared experience aims to inspire future conservation efforts and demonstrate that achieving the 30x30 target requires a whole-of-society approach that values conservation outcomes wherever they occur.
